

# K–6 Curriculum Implementation and Supports Timeline

2022

April

- Final K–6 English Language Arts and Literature, Mathematics, and Physical Education and Wellness curriculums are released.
- The Curriculum Implementation Information Hub is available on [new.LearnAlberta.ca](https://new.LearnAlberta.ca) for ongoing support for teachers and parents.
- The Explore Resources section on [new.LearnAlberta.ca](https://new.LearnAlberta.ca) provides access to authorized resources that support the implementation of new curriculum.

2022

May

- Revised draft K–6 Science, French Immersion Language Arts and Literature, and French First Language and Literature curriculums are released.

2022

September

- All Alberta schools implement new K–3 English Language Arts and Literature, K–3 Mathematics, and K–6 Physical Education and Wellness curriculums.
- Optional implementation of grades 4–6 English Language Arts and Literature and Mathematics curriculums begins.
- Classroom piloting begins for draft K–6 Science, French Immersion Language Arts and Literature, and French First Language and Literature curriculums.

2023

March

- Final K–6 Science, French Immersion Language Arts and Literature, and French First Language and Literature curriculums are released.
- Supports for implementation, including professional learning videos, bridging documents, and subject overviews, are available to teachers in the Curriculum Implementation Information Hub on [new.LearnAlberta.ca](https://new.LearnAlberta.ca).

2023

March – September

- Additional resources to support new curriculum continue to be added to [new.LearnAlberta.ca](https://new.LearnAlberta.ca).
- Alberta Regional Professional Development Consortia continue to work with system leaders and school authorities to determine how to best meet the professional learning needs of teachers to support implementation of new curriculum.
- Alberta Regional Professional Development Consortia provide professional learning in English and French to support curriculum implementation.

2023

April

- In early April, school authorities receive funding for teacher professional learning and learning and teaching resources to support teachers and students with the updated K–6 curriculum in classrooms. This includes:
  - \$45 on a per student basis to purchase additional curriculum resources to support implementation of new K–6 curriculum in three subject areas, and
  - \$800 on a per teacher basis to support professional learning.

2023

September

- All Alberta school authorities implement new curriculums for:
  - Grades 4–6 English Language Arts and Literature and Mathematics, and
  - K–3 Science, French Immersion Language Arts and Literature, and French First Language and Literature.
- School authorities have the option to implement grades 4–6 Science, French Immersion Language Arts and Literature, and French First Language and Literature curriculums.

2024

September

- All Alberta school authorities implement new grades 4–6 Science, French Immersion Language Arts and Literature, and French First Language and Literature curriculums.
