2024-25 Start Up Information

We are excited to welcome families to our Meet the Staff on Friday, August 30 from 8:30 a.m. to 9:30 a.m. This practice allows families to drop off school supplies and allows your children to meet their teacher and find their classroom prior to the first day of school. Homeroom teachers will be in contact with you via email on August 29, introducing themselves and welcoming students to their classes.

In order to further support our students in their transition to their new grade, we utilize a staggered entry system. Staggered Entry for Grades 1-4 will occur on September 3 and September 4. On Tuesday, September 3, students with last names beginning with A-L will attend school. Students with last names beginning with M-Z will attend their first day on Wednesday, September 4. All students will attend class on Thursday, September 5. Please note, this staggered entry structure will not impact Pre-Kindergarten and Kindergarten as they have a separate staggered entry schedule that has been communicated to them.
